the National Council αf Educational Research & Training (NCERT). 250 schools with the name 'Composite Model Schools' have been established in the Union Territoy of Delhi only and in no other State or Union Territory of the Country. These schools owned and maintained by Delhi Administration are not funded by the Government of India. While the other schools run by Delhi Administration are from class VI onwards, the 'Composite Model Schools' start from Pre-primary/Primary Stage onwards. Extra funds are sanctioned by Delhi Administration to the 'Composite Model Schools' for purchase of swings and other articles for use of little children. The Administration have also sanctioned one post of Hobby Teacher and one post of Ayah in these schools.

Rush for English Books at 11th World Book Fair

3371. SHRI KRISHAN LAL SHARMA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that in the 11th World Book Fair held recently in the capital stalls of books in English drew big crowds as compared to stalls of regional languages;

 - (e) if so, when?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELIA): (a) The Notional Book Trust has intimated that at the New Delhi World Book Fair, the stalfs of books in English attracted larger crowds compared to other stalls.

(b) to (e) Government are aware of the need to encourage publishing in Indian languages and the NBT has taken several steps in this regard.

Change in Examination System in Univer-

3373. SHRI KRISHAN LAL SHARMA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a number of commissions have suggested change in the examination system in the Universities in the country;
- (b) whether Government have accepted the suggestions and if so, when it is likely to be implemented; and
 - (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) and (b) According to the information furnished by UGC, several Commissions and Committees have given suggestions regarding change in the examination system. Based on these suggestions, the UGC has advised the universities to implement certain specific

measures of examination reforms like continuous internal evaluation, development of question banks, grading system, semester system, re-designing of syllabus and question papers, etc.

National Cultural Mutual Complex

- 3374. SHRI SATISH PRADHAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the Ministry has already set up National Cultural Mutual Complex, (NCMC) if so, what are the details thereof;
- (b) what are the functions of NCM Complexes;
- (c) what is the total allocation for this activity and how much has been spent, so far, location-wise; and
- (d) how different are the activities of NCM Complexes from the other Government aided institutes?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE (DEPARTMENT DEVELOPMENT EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) and (b) No, Sir. However, a scheme for setting up Multi-purpose Cultural Complexes in States has been formulated. Under this scheme the land is to be given free of cost by the State Government and the State Government concerned has to identify autonomous organisation for setting up this complex. The Central Government finances generally upto a maximum of Rs. 1 crore for each of the complexes. The balance expenditure and recurring administrative expenditure will have to be borne by the State Government concerned.

(c) The allocation for the scheme during the current year is Rs. 2 crores and so far, an amount of Rs. 80 lakhs has been sanctioned for defray to Governments of Sikkim, Nagaland, West Bengal, Manipur and Madhya Pradesh.

(d) The scheme provides an integrated complex to facilitate all cultural activities like performing arts, literary activities and exhibitions including libraries and seminar facilities.

Allocation of Funds in Sports
