#### **Privatisation of ancillary services in Railways**

4806. SHRI KRISHAN LAL SHARMA :  
Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have decided to privatise a number of ancillary services in various railway stations;

(b) if so, the details of these services and the time by when these are likely to be privatised;

(c) the estimate of savings as a result of privatisation;

(d) the criteria to be adopted to select private enterprise in this regard; and

(e) the number of workers likely to be affected and the mode of use of services of those likely to be rendered surplus as a result of the same ?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. K. JAFFER SHARIEF) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) A scheme of beautification-cum-maintenance of Bandra Station in lieu of sole advertisement rights at specified sites by an advertiser has been started. This has been extended to a few more stations over Indian Railways.

(c) The scheme has been introduced recently. No assessment of saving in expenditure as a result of privatisation has yet been made.

(d) Contract at Bandra Station was finalised on single tender basis on experimental basis. At other stations the same is finalised by calling the tenders.

(e) No staff will be rendered surplus on account of introduction of the above scheme.
