## Privatisation of ancillary services in **Railways**

#### THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. K. JAFFER SHARIEF): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) A scheme of beautification-cummaintenance of Bandra Station in lieu of sole advertisement rights at specified sites by an advertiser has been started. This has been extended to a few more stations over Indian Railways.
- (c) The scheme has been introduced recently. No assessment of saving in expenditure as a result of privatisation has yet been made.
- (d) Contract at Bandra Station was finalised on single tender basis on experimental basis. At other stations the same is finalised by calling the tenders.
- (e) No staff will be rendered surplus on account of introduction of the above scheme.
