The Government is promoting foreign as well as domestic tourism in the country including Pondicherry through its 18 overseas offices by advertising in print & electronic media, participation in travel fairs, inviting media, and Travel Agents on familiarization trips, extensive use of Information Technology in tourism promotion etc. Domestic tourism is encouraged through 21 domestic offices within India.

Maintenance and Management of Taj Mahal by a Private Company

† 448. SHRI JHUMUK LAL BHENDIA: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the responsibility of maintenance and management of the historical Taj Mahal has been entrusted to a private company; if so, whether the Archaeological Survey of India was unable to maintain it;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) the details of agreement entered into with the company and amount involved therein?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) to (c) No, Sir. The Indian Hotels Company Ltd. have signed a MoU with the National Culture Fund and the Archaeological Survey of India to provide financial assistance towards conservation, environment development and improvement of tourist related amenities at the Taj Mahal, Agra. All conservation measures identified under the MoU will be carried out by the Archaeological Survey of India alone.

The creation of tourist related facilities and improvement of the environment will be promoted directly by the donor under strict terms and conditions laid down by the Archaeological Survey of India.

In the first phase of the project Rs. 1.87 crores has been earmarked for conservation, chemical preservation and beautification of the Taj Mahal.
