BASAVARAJESWARI): (a) and (b) The recent survey undertaken by National Nutrition Monitoring Bureau (NNMB) shows that the prevalance of malnutrition among children (1-5 years) is as under:

- (i) Severly malnourished 8.7% (wt. less than 60% of standard weight).
- (ii) Moderate 43.8% (wt. 60%-75% of standard weight).
- (iii) Mild 37.6% (wt. 75%-90% of standard weight).
- (c) The Government has taken various steps for raising the nutritional status of Some of the major interventions are the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme, Balwadi Nutrition Programme (BNP) and the scheme of Creches. The Child Survival and Safe Motherhood Programme has been launched with a view to reduce infant mortality rate and improve the nutritional status of infants. In addition, Prophylaxis Programme against nutritional anaemia and vitamin-A deficiency, National Iodine Deficiency Disorder Control Programme as well as Nutrition Education Interven tions have also been undertaken
