THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT) (SMT. BASAVARAJESWARI) :

(b) During the Conference, issues on Maternal and New born care. Reproductive health of adolescent and young people. Baby Friendly Hospital Approach, ORT, Guinea Worm Eradication, Water and Sanitation, Community health and Community participation interalia were discussed.

The Meeting endorsed the Goals of Education for all by the year 2000. The meeting emphasised the need for political commitment to ensure that all concerned sectors develop a coordinated Plan of Action with appropriate budget allocations in respect of multisectoral school based packages.

Facility of Creches for Kendriya Vidya-laya Sangathan

(a) whether benefits of the Scheme of Creches/Day Care Centres started by Government in 1975 are admissible to its autonomous organisations fully funded and controlled by it;

(b) if so, what are the conditions etc. of the admissibility;

(c) whether Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has ever approached the Department of Women and Child Development requesting for extension of the said benefits to its employees; and

(d) if so, the details thereof, and reaction of the Department thereto ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT) (SMT. BASAVARAJESWARI) : (a) No, Sir. The object of the Scheme of Creches/Day Care Centre is to benefit children of poor working or ailing women. The benefits of the scheme are available only to those children whose parents' income does not exceed Rs. 1800/- per month. The ceiling income of both the parents was Rs. 300/- per month till 1-4-1991 when it was revised to Rs. 1800/- per month.

Mainnourished children in the country

5106. SHRI RAHASBIHARI BARIK : Will the Minister of HUMAN RE-

SOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to State :

(a) whether Government have made any estimate of the malnourished children in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps taken by Government for the welfare of these children?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT) : (SMT. BASAVARAJESWARI) : (a) and (b) The recent survey undertaken by National Nutrition Monitoring Bureau (NNMB) shows that the prevalence of malnutrition among children (1-5 years) is as under :

(i) Severely malnourished 8.7% (wt. less than 60% of standard weight).

(ii) Moderate 43.8% (wt. 60%-75% of standard: weight).

(iii) Mild 57.6% (wt. 75%-90% of standard weight).

(c) The Government has taken various steps for raising the nutritional status of Children. Some of the major interventions are the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDIS) Scheme, Balwadi Nutrition Programme (BNP) and the scheme of Creches. The Child Survival and Safe Motherhood Programme has been launched with a view to reduce infant mortality rate and improve the nutritional status of infants. In addition, Prophylaxis Programme against nutritional anaemia and vitamin-A deficiency, National Iodine Deficiency Disorder Control Programme as well as Nutrition Education Interventions have also been undertaken.
