THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. C. SILVERA): (a) Data, on prevalence of migraine has not been compiled.

(b) and (c) A number of prophylactic treatments are available for migraine.

Construction of primary Health Centres in Gujarat

1168. SHRIMATI ANANDIBEN JETHABHAI PATEL: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government of Gujarat has sought funds for the construction of Primary Health Centres;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) what steps Government have proposed to update and improve the primary health centres in that State?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. C. SILVERA): (a) and (b) No, Sir.

(c) Primary Health Centres are maintained by the State Governments. However, provisions has been made for construction of 38 training annexes at primary health centres in Gujarat under the World Bank Assistance India Population Project-VII. Under Social Safety Net Scheme 5 PHCs each per year are also being supported for Banaskantha and Kutch districts for construction of an Operation Theatre, six bedded observation ward and resident-quarters for LHV/ANM.

World Bank's assistance to control Tuberculosis

(a) whether the World Bank has recently proposed to assist India in reducing incidence of tuberculosis;

(c) whether the incidence of tuberculosis has been showing increasing trends in the country in recent years;

(d) if so, the details thereof for the last three years;

(e) whether the World Bank's assistance will help in augmenting the supply of major drugs used for treatment of tuberculosis; and

(f) if so, the details thereof?
