(a) whether it is a fact that a large number of coaches have become old, outdated and damaged;

(b) if so, the estimated number of such coaches;

(c) the steps taken to repair and replace such coaches; and

(d) the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. K. JAFFER SHARIEF):
(a) and (b) No, Sir. Some coaches which have crossed their codal life are being retained in service only after ensuring the requisite standards. The number of such coaches used for passenger traffic are as follows:-
