(b) and (c) Government have apprised the international community of the dangers inherent in the support extended by Pakistan to terrorism. Government have also strongly urged Pakistan on several occasions and at various levels to stop its support to subversion and terrorism and are firmly resolved to take all necessary measures to counter Pak support to terrorism and to safeguard the unity and integrity of the nation.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. M. SAYEED): (a) and (b). The analysis of the basic census data of the 1991 Census has been completed. The list of publications brought out so far is given in the statement enclosed. (See below).

- (c) The analysis of the remaining sophisticated census data such as relating to detailed age tables social cultural, economic characteristics, migration and fertility etc. is likely to be completed in phases during the period 1994—97.
- (d) Copies of all the 1991 Census publications will be made avilable to the Parliament Library for the use of the Members of Parliament.
