The balance amount on account of exchange rate fluctuations is not available with the Government of India since Overseas Development Administration. U.K. (ODA) had earmarked funds for specific agreed, project activities only. However, for the present the fund requirements of FP&ARD are being met out of the over all budget allocations of the HFC. The Department of Fertilizers through the Ministry of Finance has requested ODA that the unspent balance should flow to the fertilizer sector for agriculture education and extension work. However, fund allocation for projects does not depend on any previous balance, but on their viability.
