Kendriya Vidyalaya in Upper Assam

4283. SHRI N. GIRI PRASAD: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of locations of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KV) in Upper Assam districts, district-wise;
- (b) the names of educational institutions in the said districts, districtwise having affiliation with Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)
- (c) the names of educational institutions in said districts, location-wise whose management is controlled by minority communities with details of medium of instruction in each such institution;
- (d) the details of amounts of grants received by institutions as in (c) from Government during the last five years, year-wise and institution-wise;
- (e) whether Government are aware of severe hardship being faced by a large number of students related to Central Government employees/staff in Dibrugarh area with transferable job throughout the country due to no Kendriya Vidyalaya at Dibrugarh; if so, whether Government propose to set up Kendriya Vidyalaya at Dibrugarh and by when; and
 - (f) if not, reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE

DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) to (f) Kendriya Vidyalaya are not opened on district/ statewise basis. They are opened in Civil and Defence Sectors where there is a concentration of transferable Govt. employees. The Vidyalayas are also opened in Project sectors and in the Institutions of higher learning where the sponsoring agencies agrees to meet the recurring and non-recurring expenditure for running the school and also provides the necessary infrastructural facilities. A list of schools, including KVs in Assam affiliated to CBSE is at Annex. (see below).

Govt. of India does not give financial aids to private schools. CBSE grants affiliation to schools irrespective of whether the institutions are managed by any particular community. The medium of instruction in all CBSE affiliated schools are Hindi/English.

KVS has intimated that there are already 6 Kendriya Vidyalayas in Dibrugarh District including one at Air Force Station of Dibrugarh which is within 10 Kilometers from the main city of Dibrugarh. A proposal was received from the Distt. Administration of Dibrugarh in 1992 for opening a K.V. but there was no commitment regarding provision of infrastructural facilities which are required as per the norms. Though matter has been taken up with the Distt. Administration, there has been no response from them yet.
