Command Area Development Programme

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DE-VELOPMENT AND IN THE MINI-STRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI P. K. THUNGON): (a) to (f) A Centrally sponsored Command Area Development Programme under implementation in the Country since 1974-75. Funds towards central assistance are being released by the Central Government to States based on the quantum of physical works done, expenditure incurred by the States and amount admissible as per current financial pattern. As such there is no diversion of earmarked funds to other programmes.

Monitoring of the programme is being done by the State and Centre through quarterly/Annual Progress Reports, periodical visits. Annual Plan, discussions and at the time of release of funds to States. During 8th Five Year Plan, Strengthening of monitoring cells is also being proposed at the project and State levels. An advisory Committee headed by the Hon'ble Minister of Water Resources and Parliamentary Affairs has also been constituted during 1994 by the Government of India to oversee the effective implementation of the Command Area Development Programme.

Rajiv Gandhi National Training and Research Institute for Ground Water
