Besides, State Governments are also providing assistance for area expansion and control of pasts etc., from their State Plan fund.

- (c) and (d) As per existing Exim Policy, export of basmati rice is allowed freely and that of non-basmoti rice (10 lakh metric tonnes in a good production year and 5 lakh metric tonnes in bad year of production) subject to Minimum Export Price (MEP) of US \$ 200 per metric ton (PMT). Similarly, Export of wheat products is also allowed freely. Export of wheat, coarse grains and pulses are allowed to be exported subject to quantitative ceilings released every year having regard to the production and availability.
