In addition, the Government has now introduced a Scheme of Pension to Meritorious Sports persons under which all Olympic medal winners are entitled for a life pension of Rs. 2000/per month from the age of thirty years.

## (c) No, Sir.

There was no scheme for felicitation of coaches of Olympic medal winners till 198S when the Drona-charya Awards were instituted. Under the Scheme those coaches who have I trained sportapersons or teams

achieving outstanding results in the year of the award and very good results during the thres years preceding the year of the award are being honoured.

(d) In addition to the Drona-charya Award, the Government has now made a provision for grant of award to the coaches of medal winners in Olympic Games and Asian" Games in the Scheme of 'Special Awards to Winners of Medals in International Sports events' from the year 1994.
