In addition, the Government has now introduced a Scheme of Pension to Meritorious Sportspersons under which all Olympic medal winners are entitled for a life pension of Rs. 2000/- per month from the age of thirty years.

## (c) No. Sir.

There was no scheme for felicitation of coaches of Olympic medal winners till 1985 when the Dronacharya Awards were instituted. Under the Scheme those coaches who have trained sportagersons or teams achieving outstanding results in the year of the award and very good results during the three years preceding the year of the award are being honoured.


