NOTE : In respect of column (4), it is clarified that while the National Literacy Mission's preferred target age-group is 15-35, it happens that quite a few district TLGs have been approved for extended age-groups. The data-base projection (as per the 1991 census) are available only for the illiterate population of 7 years of age and above. This has accordingly been adopted as the base for working out the percentage of target coverage.
