THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE (KUMARI SELJA): (a) to (g) The Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Restructuring and Reorganisation of Teacher Education taken-up in pursuance of National Policy on Education, 1986, covers training of teachers at primary and secondary levels. Teacher training at pre-school level is not covered under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme and, therefore, information regarding nursery teacher training institutions/courses in the country is not being monitored. However, there is no Central Government institution organising such courses.

## Pre-Historic sites in Nagaland

THE DEPUTY MINISTER (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOU-RCE DEVELOPMENT (KUMARI SELJA): (a) to (d) Yes, Sir. During season 1991-92 approval was given to explore Wazeho area of Phek district; in addition during the season 1992-93 approval was given to explore the Chungliyimti area of Tuensang district and Changki area of Mokokchung district of Nagaland, to Directorate of Art and Culture Government of Nagaland. The Districts Phek and Tuensang are bordering Burma. The exploration undertaken revealed stone age habitation of neolithic period and the antiquities comprised neolithic celts, stone earrings, grinding stone, mullers, pestles and pottery lid-knob.
