THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH) : (a) and (b) According to the Zoological Survey of India, the total number of living species so far recorded in the country is 77,452. Out of these, 268 are endangered species:

(c) A list of endangered species as contained in Schedule-I of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, is given at Annexure. [see Appendix CLXV, Annexure No. 23]
