KARANAND): (a) As against the refinery throughput of about 51.4 MMT for 1991-92, the indigenous crude oil production was about 30.34 MMT. The balance was met through imports. The demand/consumption of petroleum products for 1991-92 was about 56.8 MMT as against the total production of approximately 50 MMT.

- (b) Term contracts for supply of crude oil and petroleum products for the year 1992-93 are entered into with Saudi Arabia, Iran, UAE, Kuwait, Malaysia, Russia, Bahrain and China at market related prices.
- (c) Self-sufficiency in meeting the demand will depend on our investment in exploration and development of established resources.

Railway line between Farrukhabad and Shahjahanpur

The amount spent on different types of Centres in the State of Maharashtra funded by the Central Government during 1989-90, 1990-91, 1991-92 is indicated at attached statement-II (see below). The district-wise information is being collected from the State Government.

The number of persons in each district of the State who underwent Vasectomy/ Tubectomy operations during 1990-91 is at attached Statement III [See below] The district-wise information for 1991-92 is being collected. The total number of Vasectomy and Tubectomy operations done in Maharashtra during 1991-92 is indicated below:
