(a) what were the export of jute goods both in quantity and value during the years 1990-91 and 1991-92; and

(b) the countries where jute goods were exported?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI ASHOK GEHLOT): (a) The exports of jute goods during 1990-91 and 1991-92 were as below:

## Production of Cotton Cloth

1569. SHRI NARREDDY THULASI REDDY: Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that production of cotton cloth has been decreasing year by year;
  - (b) if so, what are the reasons therefor;
- (c) what steps are proposed to be taken to increase production of cotton cloth;
- (d) what was the production of cotton cloth during the years 1989-90, 1990-91 and 1991-92; and
- (e) what is the target fixed for the year 1992-93?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI ASHOK GEHLOT): (a) Production of cotton cloth has been increasing for the last several years. However, there was a slight decline in the year 1991-92.

- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) Textile Policy envisage maintenance of pre-eminent role of cotton as main raw material of Textile Industry. Government its taking several measures like.
- (i) Modernisation of ginning and processing units.

- (ii) In the new Industrial Policy there is no restriction on setting up of mill/decentralised powerloom except locational restriction.
- (iii) Textile Machinry can be imported and duty on such machinery had already been reduced in present budget.
- (iv) Textile Modernisation Fund was created in 1986 and upto the end of March, 92 sanctioned an amount of Rs. 1367 crores in respect of 357 cases out of which Rs. 836 crores have been disbursed in respect of 304 applications.
- (d) Production of cotton cloth was 12738 million sq. mts., 13398 million sq. mtrs. and 13039 million sq. mts respectively for the year 1989-90, 1990-91 and 1991-92.
- (e) As per VIII Plan projections production of cotton cloth is estimated to be 14735 million sq. mtrs. for 1992-93.
