Minority Community Member in Recruitment Board/Selection Committees

1751. SHRI MOHAMMED AFZAL ALIAS MEEM AFZAL : Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state :

(a) what are the names of the Ministries/Departments which have set up independent Recruitment Board/Selection Committees for the purpose of selection & recruitment to various categories of posts;

(b) whether there is any norm laid down by Government or by the Ministries for the appointment of a person belonging to the Minority community on these boards/selection committees;

(c) if so, which of these Rec. Board/Selection Committees are represented by the minority community; and

(d) if answer to (b) is in the negative whether Government propose to consider the question of making it mandatory for the Ministries/Departments to appoint a person belonging to the minority community on boards/selection committees; if not so, the reasons therefor ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS (SHRI-MATI MARGARET ALVA) : (a) to (d) Recruitment to Group 'A' and 'B' posts is mostly done through UPSC and to Group 'C' through Staff Selection Commission. Wherever recruitment is done by Ministries/Departments for Group 'C' posts, within their purview and for recruitment to Group 'D' posts, a Selection Committee is constituted. Where recruitment is on a large scale like in Railways, independent Recruitment Boards are set up. Instructions have already been issued to the effect that wherever a Selection Committee/Board exists or has to be constituted for making recruitment to 10 or more vacancies in Group 'C' or Group 'D' posts/services, it shall be mandatory to have one member belonging to the Scheduled

Castes/Tribes and one member belonging to the minority community in such Committees/Boards. The member from the SC/ST and minority community will be from within the overall sanctioned strength of the Selection Committee/Board which is constituted with the departmental officers of appropriate status and background, keeping in view the nature of the posts for which recruitment is to be made.
