

Wheat Research Project

1804. SHRI RAMACHANDRAN PILLAI : Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that Wheat Research Project is crippling because of funds thus adversely affecting country's efforts to increase its wheat production; and

(b) if so, the reasons for denying funds for the said project ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI K. C. LENKA) : (a) and (b) No Sir. The allocation of funds to the Wheat Research Project have been increased to Rs. 1050 lakh under VIII Plan, which is much higher than the VII Plan allocation of Rs. 304.60 lakh.

Production and Export of Pineapples and Oranges

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) what has been the production of pineapples and oranges during 1991-92;

(b) whether these fruits are exported;

(c) if so, the quantity exported during the above period; and

(d) the amount of foreign exchange earned per year ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN) : (a) Official estimates on Production of pineapples and oranges during 1991-92 are not available. However, as per rough estimates the production of pineapples and oranges during 1989-90 was 786716 and 531775 tonnes, respectively.

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) About 16 tonnes of pineapple and 871 tonnes of oranges were exported during 1991-92.

(d) There is no data regarding foreign exchange earned per year. However, during 1991-92 the foreign exchange equal to Rs. 1.31 lakh from pineapple and Rs. 15.25 lakh from oranges was earned.

Setting up of Central Marine and Fishing Training Institute

(a) whether Government propose to set up Central Marine and Fishing Training Institutes at Bhavnagar and Porbandar to promote more education in marine industry;

(b) what is the current progress report of Marine Industry in India in view of employment sources;

(c) whether proposed institutes will work under the Central Government; and

(d) what is the time schedule to function these institutes; if so, the details thereof ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN) :

(a) No, Sir.

(b) The average annual growth rate of marine fish production in India during the last 4 years had been 11.25% as compared to the World average of about 3%. The average annual growth rate in export earnings during the same period had been 40%. The present estimated employment by source in the Marine Fisheries Sector is as follows :—
