RAMACHANDRAN 1804. SHRI PILLAI: Will the Minister of AGRICUL-TURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Wheat Research Project is crippling because of funds thus adversely affecting country's efforts to increase its wheat production; and
- (b) if so, the reasons for denying funds for the said project?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI K. C. LENKA): (a) and (b) No Sir. The allocation of funds to the Wheat Research Project have been increased to Rs. 1050 lakh under VIII Plan, which is much higher than the VII Plan allocation of Rs. 304.60 lakh.

Production and Export of Pineapples and Oranges

- (a) what has been the production of pineapples and oranges during 1991-92:
 - (b) whether these fruits are exported;
- (c) if so, the quantity expented during the above period; and
- (d) the amount of foreign exchange carned per year?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN):

(a) Official estimates on Production of pineapples and oranges during 1991-92 are not available. However, as per rough estimates the production of pineapples and cranges during 1989-90 was 786716 and 531775 tennes, respectively.

- (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) About 16 tonnes of pineapple and 871 tonnes of oranges were exported during 1991-92.
- (d) There is no data regarding foreign exchange earned per year. However, during 1991-92 the foreign exchange equal to Rs. 1.31 lakh from pineapple and Rs. 15:25 lakh from oranges was carned.
