Social Forestry Programme in Andhra Pradesh

(a) the total area brought under the Social Forestry Programme during the last three years, year-wise in Andhra Pradesh;

(b) the number of trees planted during that period and how many have survived; and

(c) what is the total amount spent on this programme during that period ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI KAMAL NATH) : (a) to (c) The physical and financial achievements of afforestation/tree planting activities including Social Forestry, under the Twenty Point Programme, during the last three years in Andhra Pradesh is as given below :—

It may be mentioned that from the year 1990-91, targets are being set (and consequently achievements being reported) in terms of two mutually exclusive items, i.e. "seedlings distribution" for planting on private lands and "area coverage" for public lands, including forest lands. For the year 1989-90, the achievement was assessed in terms of area coverage only.

State-wise position of survival of saplings for the last three years is not readily available. Studies and assessments of the afforestation and tree planting activities carried out in certain States have revealed that, while there are location-wise and species-wise variations, the overall survival rate varies from 55% to 80%.
