2902. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas in the country at present;

(b) what is the student-teacher ratio in Kendriya Vidyalaya in the country;

(c) what has been the pass percentage of Kendriya Vidyalayas this year as compared to the year 1990-91; and

(d) what steps are being taken to improve the quality of education in Kendriya Vidyalayas?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA) :

(a) There are 768 Kendriya Vidyalayas in the Country at present.

(b) The student-teacher ratio in Kendriya Vidyalayas is 20:1 (approx).

(c) The pass percentage of Kendriya Vidyalayas for the years 1990-91 and 1992 is as under:
