**Setting up of Shipyard at Haldia**

3516. SHRIMATI SARALA MAHESHWARI: SHRI MD. SALIM:

Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the West Bengal Government had demanded for setting up of a shipyard at Haldia; and

(b) if so, what is Government's response thereto?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Central Government has no proposal to set up a shipyard in Haldia

under the Central Sector. However, West Bengal Government has been advised to explore the possibility of setting up a Shipyard by a private entrepreneur with foreign collaboration or in the joint Sector with the help of the State Government.
