THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI KALP NATH RAI): (a), (b) and (d) Ramagundam Stage II Super Thermal Power Project (2×500 MW) was executed by the National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC). Both the units have been synchronised in March and October 1989 respectively.

Proposal for setting up Small Units of Power Generation Districtwise

(a) whether Government have identified the districtwise demand of the electricity of different States in the country;

(b) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to set up small power stations of 25 MW to 50 MW, districtwise, to meet the requirement of districts which can produce high yield of agriculture, if electricity is made available to them; and

(c) whether any assessment has been made costwise, efficiencywise and from point of view of regular availability of electricity between setting up big thermal plant of 200 MW or above on the one hand and small thermal plants of 25 MW according to the need of various districts.

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI KALP NATH RAI): (a) As on 31.3.1992, there were 29,505 unelectrified villages in Uttar Pradesh. District-wise number of such villages is given in the Statement enclosed [see below]

(b) The unelectrified villages will be electrified in the VIIIth and subsequent Five Year Plans, subject to availability of funds and other inputs.
