COACHING AND ALLIED SCHEME FOR SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

25 Pre-examination training Centres for preparing SC/ST candidates for the Civil Services Examination have been set up in various parts of the country. These centres are run cither by the State Governments or the Universities. Financial assistance is provided to the State Government on matching grant basis (50:50) and in the case of Universities grant-in-aid is given to them on 100% basis provided infrastructure facilities like classhostel accommodation rooms. library facilities, etc. are made available by the Universities. In addition to this private institution a of repute viz. Rau's IAS Study Circle, New Delhi has also been entrusted with the work of providing coaching facilities to the SC/ST candidates for Civil Services Examination, like IAS, IPS etc. on contract basis.

PATTERN OF THE SCHEME: Under the scheme coaching is provided to the SC/ST candidates free of cost and no fees is charged from them. Hostel accommodation is also provided wherever such facilities are available. The mess charges arc paid at the rate of Rs. 400/- p.m. per candidate depending upon the location of the centre and stipend at the rate of Rs. 100/- per month for other candidates. The candidates arc also provided with Library facilities, and reading material

etc. The teachers are paid remuneration at the rate of Rs. 250/- per hour per lecture.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS: Merit is the main criterion for selection of SC/ ST candidates for coaching. The candidates are selected on the basis of the marks obtain in the University examination, written test and interviews.

INCOME CEILING: The SC/ST whose parents 'or guardians' total income from all sources, including the income of the candidates, does not exceed Rs. 24,000/anually, will be elegible for admission in the prc-cxaminations training centres.

COACHING FOR SECOND TIME: The.candidates who had earlier received coaching once in a particular course under this scheme and failed to compete in the examination are, however, allowed the benefits of coaching for the Second time.
