### Training of Sportsmen

3874. DR. NARREDDY THUSASI REDDY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) how many sportsmen are undergoing training under the Boys Sports Companies in the various Regimental Centres of the Army; and

(b) what are the criteria for receiving training in these Centre?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) 484 boys are receiving training under the scheme.

(b) The concerned Regional Regimental Centres are authorised to scout talent from neighbouring States on the basis of physiological and field tests to assess mortar qualities of the children between the age groups 8-14 years.
