The Government's policy has been, on the one hand, to deal firmly with those indulging in secessionist activities, and, on the other, to encourage them to join the mainstream of the national life provided they accept the Constitution of India and shun violence. Government have accelerated the pace of economic development in the region by making higher allocation of plan funds, undertaking several projects under the Central Sector, and treating all the seven north-eastern States as 'special category States'.

AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI M. M. JACOB): (a) Since 'Public Order' and 'Police' are State subjects, no data in regard to police encounters in the states is compiled at the Central Government level.

(b) Registration, investigation, detection and prevention of crime being the responsibility of the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations, it is for the respective State Government to enquire into such allegations and punish those who may be found guilty. No details in this case are available with the Central Government.
