**CBI Inquiry into Irregularities in Selection of Sponsored Serials**

194. SHRI GHUFRAN AZAM:  
SHRI VITHALBHAI M. PATEL:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that CBI has found certain Doordarshan officials and others having committed alleged irregularities in the selection of sponsored serials;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof and what action Government are taking against the guilty officials;

(c) whether Government propose to review its policy in the selection of sponsored serials;

(d) if so, what are the details in this regard; and

(e) by when Government would clear

the pending sponsored TV serials which are not involed in these irregularities?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (KUMARI GIRIJA VYAS): (a) and (b) The CBI has proposed to register P.E. against some officials of Doordarshan and conduct an open probe to ascertain whether the officials have committed any criminal misconduct.

(c) No, Sir.

(d) Does not arise.

(e) Doordarshan has been directed to priorities the serials in respect of which CBI has not reported any irregularities. The prioritisation will be done on the basis of programme requirement of Doordarshan.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (KUMARI GIRIJA VYAS): (a) to (c) While Akashvani has no proposal, at present, to increase its entertainment programmes, Doordarshan is restructuring its National programme with effect from 01.01.1993 to include suitable additional programmes for catering to viewers' interests.
