

रेल मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री मल्लिकार्जुन):  
(क) जी, हां, लेकिन यूनाइटेड कमर्शियल बैंक में कोई धनराशि जमा नहीं करई गई थी;

(ख) वर्ष 1990-91 और 1991-92 के दौरान, भारतीय रेल वित्त निगम द्वारा सिटी बैंक और कैनबैंक फाइनेंशियल सर्विसेज लिमिटेड के पास जमा करई गई धनराशि का ब्यौरा नीचे दिया गया है:—

(ग) से (घ) जहां तक 1990-91 के दौरान जमा करई गई धनराशि का संबंध है निगम को वह सभी राशि प्राप्त हो गई है, जो उसे देय थी। 1992-93 के दौरान कैनफिना के पास जमा करये गये 95.85 करोड़ रुपये में से देय तिथि को कोई राशि प्राप्त नहीं हुई थी। लेकिन 40 करोड़ रुपये की राशि किल्लों में प्राप्त हो गई है।

(ङ) कोंकण रेल परियोजना को पूरा करने की लक्ष्य तिथि अक्टूबर, 94 है, कोंकण परियोजना के लिए बांडों के फलीभूत होने में यदि और विलम्ब होता है, तो धन की तंगी से इस लक्ष्य की पूर्ति पर प्रभाव पड़ सकता है। बहरहाल, अभी इतनी जल्दी इसका सही-सही अनुमान लगा पाना कठिन है।

**Late running of Darjeeling Mail and Kanchanjunga Express**

\*28 SHRIMATI SARALA MAHESHWARI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Darjeeling Mail and Kanchanjunga Express are mostly running late; and

(b) if so, the steps proposed to be taken to run these two trains in time?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) During October 1992, Darjeeling Mail and Kanchanjunga Express reached their destination right time on 22 days. Similarly during

November 1992 (upto 20th) these trains reached right time on 13 days.

(b) Instructions already exist to ensure punctual running of trains by intensive chasing and round the clock monitoring. Extraneous factors like bandhs, agitations on issues not concerning railways, miscreant activities including unauthorised alarm chain pulling and thefts of Railway property etc., however, continue to affect punctuality of trains.

**Damage to Railway track near Trichy**

SHRI RAJNI RANJAN SAHU:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that a major train accident was averted by the timely action of the Driver who spotted damage in the railway track near Trichy when Madras Quilon Express was moving, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether Government have ordered any inquiry into the incident, if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether any evidence of involvement of LTTE militants in this incident has been detected?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) On 24.10.92, Train No. 6105 Madras-Quilon Express stopped between Kallagam-Kallakkudi Palanganatham stations of Ariyalur. Tiruchahirapalli section of Sourthern Railway, at about 02.20 hrs. in the night due to two rail length of track damage on bridge No.276. This was possible due to the alertness of the Driver of the Train.

(b) "Q" branch of C.I.D. is investigating the case as ordered by Director General of Police, Tamilnadu.

(c) the matter is still under investigation by the Tamil Nadu Police.
