

TB Hospitals and Centres in M.P.

317. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of TB hospitals and TB centres that are functioning at present in Madhya Pradesh with the details of each district in the State;

(b) whether Central Government provides funds for the proper maintenance and functioning of such TB hospitals and centres in the State;

(c) if so, what are the details thereof;

(d) whether Government are aware that most of the TB hospitals and TB centres in the State are completely in disarray; and

(e) if so, what remedial steps Government propose to take to improve the conditions of TB hospitals and centres in Madhya Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRIMATI D.K. THARA DEVI SIDDHARTHA): (a) Under the National TB Control Programme, fully equipped and staffed District TB Centres are functioning in 45 Districts of the State of Madhya Pradesh. In addition there are 4 other T B Clinics in the State. In all there are 1985 TB Beds in the State. District-wise details are given in the enclosed Statement. (See below)

(b) to (e) National TB Control Programme is implemented as a centrally sponsored scheme. Anti TB drugs/material and equipments are being supplied to the TB Centres run by State Governments on 50:50 sharing basis as per the pattern of assistance laid down by the Planning Commission.

Maintenance and functioning of TB Hospitals and TB Centres however comes under State Plan Sector and is primarily the concern of the State Govt.
