

Gas Reserves in the country

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) what are the explored and available gas reserves in the country;

(b) what is yearly exploitation from these reserves at present;

(c) what is the demand, supply and short falls;

(d) what is the Capital invested so far in oil exploration and what is the capital required to exploit enough gas to meet the growing demand including investment in reduction to zero gas flaring project; and

(e) what are the on-going projects for exploration and exploitation of gas by Government Agencies, Semi-Government Agencies and Private Agencies?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) to (c) Balance recoverable reserves of natural gas as on 1.1.92 were 730 billion cubic metres. The production of natural gas in 1991 was 18.65 billion cubic metres. While allocation of about 90 million cubic metres per day have been made based on estimates of availability, demand of about 240 MMSCMD is registered with GAIL.

(d) and (e) Cumulative expenditure so far on exploration for oil and gas by ONGC and OIL is about Rs 7868.7 crores. Investment planned in the Eighth plan period by these two companies on gas development schemes is about Rs. 9732.78 crores which includes Rs. 5650 crores for the Gas Flaring Reduction Project. Other on-going projects which

include gas development include additional development of L-II and L-III reservoirs of Bombay High field, Neelam, R-15A, Rawa, Panna, Gandhar, S 1 Sand, ICP-Heera Pipeline, Second Bassein Hazira Pipeline and expansion of Hazira Gas Terminal. While no projects for exploration and exploitation of gas are presently being implemented by semi-Government or private agencies, contracts for four blocks have been finalised with private companies for exploration of oil and gas under the Fourth Round of bidding and several oil and gas fields have been offered to private companies for development including the Mid and South Tapti gas field in the Western offshore.

(घ) चालू वर्ष के दौरान इसके कारण दोषी पाए गए खाना पकाने की गैस के विक्रेताओं तथा गैस भरने की कंपनियों के अधिकारियों के विरुद्ध कितने मामले दर्ज किए गए?
