

Assistance for Sugar Factories in Maharashtra

763. SHRI V. RAMESHWAR RAO : Will (he Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state what decision Government have taken on the Maharashtra Government's request for providing additional funds to the National Cooperative Development Corporation so as to enable it to provide assistance to the sugar factories ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme an outlay of Rs. 350.00 crores has been proposed by National Cooperative Development Corporation for supplementing the resources of the State Government for share capital participation in the new cooperative sugar factories during the 8th Plan period. The outlay proposed by NCDC has since been agreed to by the Government of India. This outlay is expected to take care of assistance to cooperative sugar factories in India, including sugar factories in Maharashtra.
