## Privileges of Non-Tribals in Shillong

1106. SHRI SUDHIR RANJAN MAJUMDAR: Will the MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether permanent non-tribals in considerable number of nan tribals living in Shillong, whose forefathers came there more than 130 years ago when the British Government made Shillong the Capital of the than Assam, covering Assam Valley, Surma Valley and Hills of the region;
- (b) whether, as permanent residents of Shillong, they are entitled to all the privileges and rights given to a citizen whatever may be their religion;
- (e) if so, whether they are enjoying those rights; and
  - (d) if net, the reasons thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI M.M. JACOB): (a) A considerable number of non-tribals are living uv Shillong for many decades.

(b) to (d) The permanent non-tribal, residents of Shillong enjoy privileges and rights as citizens of this country subject

to restrictions imposed under provisions of Sixth Schedule to the Constitution.

## Succession Certificates to the Non-Tribals in North Eastern States

1107. SHRI SUDHIR RANJAN MAJUMDAR: Will the Ministei of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether permanent noo-tribals in North Eastern States are finding it difficult to get Succession Certificates for transfer of land or permission for sale or purchase of land in their home State in Meghalaya;
- (b) whether the Autonomous District Council there is withholding permission in land matters for these permanent residents who have nowhere else to go now;
- (c) if so, what is the number of such cases that are pending;
- (d) whether these people are treated as minorities either as ethnic groups or as religious groups; and
- (e) if so, whether they are given all the facilities given to the minorities, elsewhere?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE **PARLIAMENTARY** MINISTRY OF AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI M. M. JACOB): (a) to (c) The State legislation governing transfer of land prohibits transfer of land from tribals to non-tribals. The Succession Certificates in the Meghalaya are issued by the Autonomous District Council Courts in case of land/property being passed on to legal heirs. Some reports have been received pertaining to red-tapism, etc. in producing such Certificate by non-tribals in Shillong.

- (d) The non-tribals as such are net treated as ethnic or religious minorities in North Eastern States.
