Growing influence of militants in Jammu and Kashmir

DR. NAUNIHAL SINGH (Uttar Pradesh): Mr. Vice-Chairman, Sir, I visited the State of Jammu and Kashmir with two other Members of the Lok Sabha on the 14th, 15th and 16th of August. A very serious situation has arisen in that State due to the faulty policies of the Central Government on a continuing basis. Infiltrators are pouring into Jammu and Kashmir from Pakistan. The population of the State of Jammu and Kashmir is increasing with these infiltrators. Innocent and loyal people like Gujar Muslims are being beaten and killed. On 27-6-1992, a Gujar boy from Village Chalhas, District Rajouri, was beaten and killed and even his dead body was not returned to his parents. As a result of the torture of Gujar Muslims, not less than 400 families have crossed the border into Pakistan. Over 100 girls from the area of Surankote have slipped into Pakistan for training. Eighty per cent of the police force is under the influence of the militants. If any infiltrator is caught by the military, he is handed over to the police and the police, after a brief enquiry, let him off. This is how infiltrators are let off.

Further, there is another alarming situation in the State. The State Govern-

ment is financing certain newspapers which print anti-India material and encourage militancy. I have collected those papers. These are Urdu papers. Anybody can read them. The papers are "Alsafa", "Srinagar Times", "Aftab", "Vadi-ki-Awaz" and "Khidmat Press". The provincial financial corporation has advanced loans to the extent of one crore and thirty-seven lakhs of rupees to the first four papers. The fifth paper, "Khidmat Press", got Rs. 80 lakhs. They are publishing anti-India material and are encouraging insurgency.

Another alarming situation is that the PTT/UNI agencies are now manned by those people who have been appointed with the recommendation of the militants. So wrong news are being given to the various newspapers. The foreign media is represented by no less than 172 persons as against two persons in 1947, all accredited and given all the facilities Mr. Doraiswamy got released on 21st August. It came in newspapers on 26th August. It is reliably learnt that not less than Rs. 10 lakhs was paid to the militants for the release; in addition, Rs. 1 lakh was paid to these papers only to print an advertisement saying, on behalf of the militants, "Thanks" and "Shukriya." This is surprising. And, all this amount is recorded in the Indian Oil Corporation records.

Lastly, Sir, Dr. Farooq Abdullah, in a recent statement, which is very damaging, has added fuel to fire. It should be viewed by the Government with all the seriousness as it is anti-India and amounts to betrayal of the trust of the people and the nation.

All these constitute an explosive situation in the State of Jammu and Kashmir and heard the darkest clouds over the horizon of the State and the nation as a whole. And, a ground seems to have been prepared for an attack by Pakistan. Through you, Sir, I warn the Government for preparedness, full preparedness. They should prepare themselves more than 100 per cent to defend themselves and, if necessary, destroy the training centres for Militants in Pakistan to protect the people of the country. Thank you.
