SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY (Andhra Pradesh) : Madam, you have.. (*Interruptions*)

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA (BIHAR) : Madam, how do you respond to the fact that at this point of time—you have adjourned the House till 12—that two senior Ministers of the Government were not present ? They have not even shown the due courtesy to this House. Is this the manner in which the House should be treated What is happening to parliamentary democracy ? (*Interruptions*)----- This is a very serious matter. Any other Government would have died a thousand deaths if they had behaved like this. (*Interruptions*)..

SHRI DIPEN GHOSH (West Bengal) : Have the Government sought for voluntary retirement ? (*Interruptions*)....

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : I don't know. (*Interruptions*)-----

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : We want you to censure the Government. (*Interruptions*).. You must censure the Government. (*Interruptions*)....

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : I will find out where they were. (*Interruptions*) ____

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : You have to censure the Government. *(Interruptions)* Here and now you have to censure the Government. *(Interruptions)*....

SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY : Where is the Government ? How can the House function ? *(Interruptions)*

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : The Ministers are paid for being present. It is a gross dereliction of duty. *(Interruptions)*....

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : Please, just a minute. Kindly take your leave. *(Interruptions)* There are Ministers present, you cannot say "there are no Ministers present". There is Kumari Mamta Banerjee, Kumari Silja, Mr. Sukh Ram. *(Interruptions)*...

Shri S. JAIPAL REDDY : No no, Madam. *(Interruptions)*

SHRI MENTAY PADMANA-BHAM (Andhra Pradesh) : Sir, Madam. The business of the House was suspended on a particular issue and nobody is here when we take up that issue. *(Interruptions)*

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : I am not raising that issue. I am raising the issue of laying of papers on the Table of the House for which Ministers are supposed to be present in the House and they are absent without notice. You, are saying you will find out. *(Interruptions)*

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : What can I do ? *(Interruptions)*...

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : You must censure the Government *(Interruptions)*.... You must censure the Government. *(Interruptions)*...

SHRI S. J. BRAMANIAN : What do they ask for your permission?

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA (West Bengal) : We want the Leader of the House to be present in the House. *(Interruptions)*....

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : I had announced in the House that Mr. Arjun Singh did not give me permission because he said that he was not feeling well and he wanted to go to the hospital.

SHRI MENTAY PADMANA-BHAM : What about Mr. M. V. Ramachandran ? What about others ? *(Interruptions)*....

SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY : What about Mr. V.C. Shukla ? *(Interruptions)*....

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : I don't know. *(Interruptions)*....

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : We know what is going on in the other House. So, there is no reason for the Leader of the House. ... *(Interruption!)*....

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : Now the Leader of the House has come. *(Interruptions)*....

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : All right. There is no reason. One of them had to be present here. It is your direction that one of the Ministers in the Parliamentary Affairs Ministry should be present in the House. Mr. Jacob is not present here. *(Interruptions)*....

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : May be he is busy in the other House. *(Interruptions)*.... He must be busy with some work in the other House. Let me find out. *(Interruptions)* I cannot give any ruling without finding out.... *(Interruptions)*....

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA : There is no question of ruling. If a Minister is absent without notice to you—a Minister who is supposed to lay papers on the Table of the

House—it is violative of the dignity of the House. It is against the privilege of the House and you must go on record by censuring the Government for this lapse. (Interruptions)... You must. (Interruptions)
