

Bank branches authorised by DESU to collect electricity bills

2855. SHRI SYED SIBTEY RAZI: Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 4628 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 31st March, 1992 and state:

(a) whether DESU has authorised certain banks to collect payment of electricity bills from consumers;

(b) if so, what are the names of branches of these banks with their working timings;

(c) whether these nominated banks have separate counters for collection of payment of these bills;

(d) whether Government propose to nominate certain more banks for extension of this facility to provide more reliefs to consumers; and

(e) if so, give details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI KALP NATH RAI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(to) The requisite information is given in the enclosed Statement. (*See below*) The electricity bills are collected by the authorised banks during normal banking hours from 10.00 AM to 2.00 PM. The different timing observed by some branches located in residential areas are also indicated in the said statement.

(c) to (e) Normally, the banks have separate counters to collect the electricity bills but these counters may sometimes be utilised for other business of the Banks depending upon the rush of consumers. DESU is willing to extend this facility but there has been no response from the Banks to the proposals invited through the papers advertisement on 20-4-1992.
