(a) the capacity of the Hazira Pipe line to carry gas and wkt per cent of this capacity is being utilised at present; if not utilised fully the reasons therefor;

(b) whether it is a fact that an Traditional pipeline is being planned to be laid from Basin to Hszira and if so. what is the proponed cost of this pipeline;

(c) if the present oipeline is not; utilised fully, what is the rational for laying the second line for the same area; and

(d) the estimated number of ferti liser and power projects "installed to utilise all these gases which have been completed and how many are yet to be completed"; what is the esti mated gestation period of Ihese plant--- to be able to utilise the entire gas. the capacity of transportation which is being created

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND):

(a) The Bas-sien to Hazira pipeline has a capacity of 20 MMSCMD and its current utilisation ranges from 90 to more than 100 per cent.

(b) Yes, Sir. The estimated cost of thie pipeline is appror. B.s. 1974 crores.

(c) In view of (a) abo-.'c, does not arise.

(d) From Hazira supplies are currently being made to "4 fertilizer and 5 power plants, while 5 fertilizer and

3 power plants are yet to be completed. The gestation periods for fertiliser and! power plants are approx 36 and 30 months respectively.
