ticket examiners to check ticketless travel in long distance Express Trains;

(b; what is the rough estimated cost of loss per year to the Railways due to ticketless travelling;

(c) the amount collected from ticketless traveller during the years 199 J 91, 1991-92 and upt₀ July, 1992; and

(d) whether any steps have been taken to put down ticketless travel in ail trains particularly in Express Trains?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) Yes, Sir. here is some need.

(b; The Loss is not quantitable.

(c) Rs. 25.12 crores, 28.53 crores and 15.43 crores were realised from ticketsles travellers during 1990-91, 1991-92 and upto June 1992 (latest available), respectively.

(d) the measures taken to curb tick etless travel include regular surprise! magisterial checks, publicity carnpuings through different media and deterrent penalties provided in the new Railways Act. Steps to create additional posts of TTEs etc. are also taken wherever justified.

Improvements in National Highways

3053. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: SHRI SURINDER KUMA⁺; SINGLA:

Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the iNational Highway Network requires considerable improvement;

(b) if so, what is the length of National Highways Network, still single iatie or wit., low-grade surface;

(c) whet is. the length of National Highways Network which is due f^{or} widening to four lane considering the traffic density;

(d) whether Government have any strategy $i_0 \mbox{ complete the above works; and }$

(e) if so. the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE EN THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Although National Highways in the country are generally i_n a traffic worthy condition, the network has certain deficiencies. Out of the total length of 33,689 kms, a length of 5636 km i_s still having single lane or low grade surfacing. Keeping in view the expected growth of traffic by 1995, a length of about 14,900 kms would need fourlaning as per the existing capacity norms.

(d) and (e) Development of National Highways is a continuing activity and improvement works ar_e being taken up on the basis of Annual Plans/ Five Year subject to availability o: funds. In the 8th Five Year Plan, an outlay of Rs. 2460.00 crores is earmar ked for the development of existing National Highways. Due to constraint; of resources, it is too early to indicate the time frame for the removal ol various deficiencies on N. H. network For this purpose, it is envisaged tc attract private sector participation a; well.
