#### **Providing Minimum Level of Education**

3393. SHRI RAMDAS AGARWAL:  
Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) what steps Government have taken so far to provide primary school education for all children within one Kilometre of walking distance and (ii) to reduce the dropout rate between Class—I and V from the existing 46 percent to 20 percent;

(b) what provision has been made under the Eighth Plan outlay for centrally sponsored schemes under "elementary education" and as well as under outlay for Annual Plan 1992-93; and

(c) whether Government hope to provide minimum level of education to all children in the country at the primary level by the end of 1997, if so, the steps taken (State-wise) so far and the central assistance likely to be provided to Rajasthan and Orissa in this regard?

**THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE

(a) The responsibility to provide universal access to primary education lies with State Governments and they work out annual requirement of opening of primary schools or non-formal education centres wherever needed and make

provision in their State plan. As per the Xth All India Education Survey (1986), 94.5 percent of the rural population is served by the primary school within a walking distance of 1 Kilometre. As regards reduction of dropouts, the causes leading to dropout being many, there is no single programme which if implemented would lead to a specified reduction in the dropout rates. The State Governments and Union Territories Administrations have taken following steps in this regard:

- (i) Provision of incentives such as free text books, free uniforms, scholarships and mid-day meals etc;
- (ii) Community mobilisation to the need for literacy;
- (iii) Appointment of female teachers;
- (iv) Provision of day care centre either near or attached to schools to take care of younger siblings.

In addition, Central assistance has been provided and will continue during VIII Plan for expansion of facilities in primary schools under the scheme of Operation Blackboard, for diversification and improvement of non-formal education, and for programmes relating to teacher training, etc.

(b) The details are given in the Statement. (See below).

(c) In the revised policy of education, it is envisaged that all children upto the age of 14 will be provided elementary education before we enter the twenty first century. As programme of action is being drawn up to achieve this goal. No state-wise allocations are made in the 8th Plan under the central sector.
