(c) which are the recommendations of the Ram Murthy Committee Report found workable and what is being done for its implementation?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) to (c) The Revised Policy Formulation (RPF) of National Policy on Education (NPE), 1986 liament on 7th May, 1992. Taking note of the importance of Population control, a specific provision regarding Population Education (Par<sub>a</sub> 8.16) ha<sub>s</sub> been incorporated in the RPF. Taking into account the developments since the formulation of NPE, 1986, revised Programme of Action (POA) is being prepared. The RPF and the

revised POA take into account, *inter alia*, the reports of the Acharya Ramamurti Committee and the Jan-ardhana Reddy Committee. The programmes for Universalisation of Elementary Education and Adult Literacy pay special attention to raising the level of literacy in the backward areas and particularly among women.
