- (c) what was the benefit recommended per gm of the drug saltwise and what basis recommendation of the BICP for giving this benefit was accepted;
- (d) whether it is a fact that the price worked out by the BICP in 1990 were lower than recommneded by Murthy Committee as well as existed price;
- (e) if so, whether it has been proved prima facie that Murthy committee was wrong; and
- (f) if so, whether Government have proposed any action against Murthy Committee for omissions and commission for consideration?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FER-TILIZERS (SHRI CHINTA MOHAN): (a) and (b) No. Sir.

- (c) The recommendation regarding benefit of cost reduction due to R&D efforts was not accepted by the Government.
- (d) BICP recommendation was to continue the existing prices, notified January, 1989.

- (e) if so, what action has been taken and what is the present status of this case?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI CHINTA MOHAN):
(a) and (b) The cases of overcharging in the prices of Proxyvon range of formulations, Revital capsules and Ibudex capsules came to the notice of Government in 1988. As already stated in reply to Rajya Sabha Unstarred Question No. 1140 dated 7-5-1992, it takes time in the cases of overcharging to arrive at a final decision because the companies deliberately avoid giving the details required by the Government for calculating the overcharged amount.

(c) No, Sir-

(d) and (e) Dextropropoxyphene is one of the bulk drugs contained in Proxyvon range of formulations. Revital is the brand name of Cinseng based formulation manufactured by M/s. Ranbaxy. Position in respect of both these cases has been explained in reply to parts (a) and (b) above.
