(d) All the major railway stations in the country have been provided with announcement system. However, this facility is being gradually extended to more stations.

Railway Tracks

3965. SHRI VENOD SHARMA: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the accumulated arrears of railway tracks renewals at the end of Sixth and Seventh five year plan in the country;

(b) what target was set for renewal of tracks during the Seventh plan and 1990-91 and 1991-92 and tracks actually renewed;

(c) what is the backlog of track renewal at the beginning of the Five Year Plan;

(d) whether it is proposed to wipe out the entire arrears by the end of 1992; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and the financial requirements for clearing the backlog?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) Arrears of track renewals at the end of VIth and VIIth

plan were 19,500 Kms. and 12,000 Kms. respectively.

(c) The assessed level of arrears at the commencement of VIIIth Plan (1.4.92) is 9,600 Kms.

(d) No Sir, with the level of allocations for track Renewals in VIII plan, only bulk of arrears on trunk routes and important BG lines would be wiped out in the VIII plan. The conversion policy will also bring down existing arrears of renewals significantly on MG system.

Freight operation information system project

(a) whether the Freight Operation Information System Project approved in 1989, is under implementation by the Centre for Railway Information Service (CRIS); and

(b) if so, what is the present status in implementation of the project?
