THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) There is no scheme called Credit Deposit Scheme under Small Savings. State-wise figures of the net Small Savings collections during 1990-91 and 1991-92 are shown in the statement laid on the Table of the House. (See below)

(b) 3/4th of net collection from Small Savings Schemes in a State is advanced as a long term loan to that State.

Utilisation of external aid

550. SHRI KAMAL MORARKA:

SHRI P. UPENDRA:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) what has been the external assistance contracted during the years 1985 to 1991;

(b) what has been the amount of the above external assistance utilised and the portion remaining unutilised as on the 1st April, 1992;

(c) what are the reasons for unutilised external aid; and

(d) what steps have been taken by Government to maximise utilisation of external assistance?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI RAMESHWAR THAKUR): (a) The ex-

ternal assistance contracted during the years 1985-86 to 1990-91 amounts to Rs. 53094 crores.

(b) The external assistance utilised during the years 1985-86 to 1990-91 amounts to Rs. 29404 crores. The overall unutilised external assistance amounts to Rs. 83485 crores as on 1st April, 1992.

(c) and (d) Most of the External Assistance is tied to specific projects and the disbursements are therefore linked to the project implementation schedule. The pace of actual implementation varies from project to project. However the loan amount not utilised during a particular financial year does not normally lapse and would be carried forward for utilization in the subsequent years. Government have taken a number of steps to accelerate the implementation of externally aided projects and the utilisation of external assistance. These include simplification of pro-
