

(d) if so, the details of funds allocated for opening of more colleges during the Seventh Plan period and the number of colleges opened; and

(e) the number of colleges likely to be opened during the Eighth Plan period?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) According to the information furnished by Delhi Administration, they had proposed opening of 10 new colleges in the VIIIth Plan to the Planning Commission. The Commission has observed that in the present circumstances it would be extremely difficult to agree to the proposals of the Administration and advised them to initiate a dialogue with the University of Delhi for opening new private colleges.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) The Delhi Administration provided Rs. 523.23 lakh during the VIIIth Plan for opening new colleges in Delhi. Four new colleges were opened during this period. In addition, three more colleges at a cost of Rs. 487.20 lakh have been opened during 1990-91 and 1991-92.

(e) Delhi Administration has not yet taken any decision in regard to the number of colleges to be opened during the VIIIth Plan.
