#### Export potential of rice flakes mixture

\*528. SHRI S. K. T. RAMACHANDRAN: Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state;

(a) whether it is a fact that the mixture of rice flakes and grains of coconut kernel and sugar, being tasty, could win foreign markets;

(b) if so, whether Government propose to formulate a scheme to investigate the possibilities of setting up small food processing industrial units in the rice growing areas?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO): (a) and (b) The Ministry of Food Processing Industries has not conducted any market survey so far to explore the possibilities of export of rice flakes, grains of coco-nut kernel and sugar to foreign markets. Hence no scheme has been formulated in this regard.
