Problems of STD subscribers

4235. SHRI S. S. SURJEWALA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether his Ministry has been receiving innumberable complaints from the STD subscribers regarding the inflated Bills;

- (b) whether it is a fact that reasons for such bills are defective Bills and metering, misuse by the staff and faulty instrumentation;
- (c) if so, whether the subscribers are opting for disconnection of STD on the face of helplessness;
- (d) whether Government propose to rescue the subscribers by removing these causes and also to provide relief to the clients, STD users who have been suffered on account of excessive Billing;
- (e) whether on account of heavy congestion on the Trunk Lines the subscribers receive the usual reply "there is a heavy traffic on this route, please dial after some time"; and
- (f) if so, whether Government propose to add more lines to remove these congestions?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI P. V. RANGAYYA NAIDU):
(a) No Sir, Complaints relating to excess billing were received in respect of only 0.75 per cent of the total bills issued during 1991-92.

- (b) These are among the reasons for the excess billing complaints. A proportion of the complaints are, on investigation, found to be not justified.
 - (c) No. Sir.
- (d) The complaints of the subscribers are examined thoroughly and relief is granted to the subscribers where the bills are found to be incorrect. Other measures like:
 - Provision of STD control facility to the subscribers from Electronic Telephone Exchanges to lock or unlock their STD facility.
 - Provision of supply of: details of STD/ISD calls to the subscribers.

- 3. Computerisation of Telephone Billing and phasing out of old telephone exchanges by installing new Electronic Exchanges are expected to further reduce the incidence of complaints.
- (e) Due to heavy calls generated by STD PCOs this message is connected on some routes. This message is also connected in case there is any link failure on some routes. But, in general this message is not connected on trunk calls.
- (f) The congestion condition is regularly monitored and action is taken to remove such congestion by adding more lines.

Interception of Telephone Messages Permitted by DOT
