

Transmission of Gas from Hazira to Utran4512. **SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA:****SHRI ANANTRAY DEVSHANKER DAVE:****SHRI SARADA MOHANTY:****SHRI VITHALBHAI M. PATEL:**

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 2986 given in the Rajya Sabha on 5th August, 1992 and state:

(a) what is Government's response to the offers of the Gujarat Government and Gujarat Electricity Board that they are prepared to bear expenses for the transmission of gas from Hazira to Utran at their own cost and their commitment that on availability of gas from the Gandhar Hazira transmitted gas would be discontinued by themselves; and

(b) whether it is a fact that 200M.W. gas-based power plant at Utran is laying idle due to non-availability of gas?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND GAS (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) The offer has not been found feasible, as the gas from the Hazira Gas Terminal is already committed to various consumers ex-Hazira and along the HBJ pipeline.

(b) An Action Plan has been prepared to expedite supplies to the second unit of the Uttaran power station. However, this is subject to GEB signing the Gas Supply Contract, and clearing the arrears due to ONGC/GAIL.

पेट्रोल पम्प खोलने को अनुमति प्रदान करना

पेट्रोलियम और प्राकृतिक गैस मंत्री (श्री बी. शंकरानंद): 1 जुलाई, 1991 से 30 जून 1992 तक सरकार ने अपने विवेकाधिकार से 19 खुदरा बिक्री केन्द्र आवंटित किए। जहाँ सरकार द्वारा अनुकंपा आधार पर स्व-विवेक से आवंटन किए जाते हैं, इसलिए राज्य-वार आवंटन का प्रश्न नहीं उठता।

Supply of L.P.G. Cylinders

(a) whether it is fact that due to short supply of L.P.G. cylinders, many consumers are not getting LPG refills in time;

(b) what is the demand and supply position of LPG cylinders, State-wise, at present; and

(c) what steps are being taken to improve the supply of LPG cylinders?
